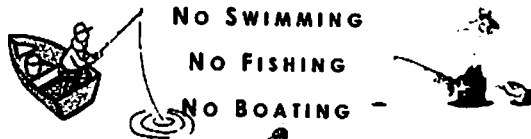

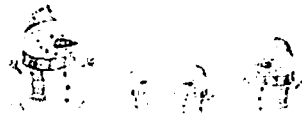

SPICY CHEESE-FILLED BREAD BOWL APPETIZER



INGREDIENTS

- 1 (1 POUND) LOAF ROUND BREAD
- 1 (8 OZ) PACKAGE SHREDDED CHEDDAR CHEESE
- 1 (8 OZ) PACKAGE CREAM CHEESE, SOFTENED
- 1 1/2 CUPS SOUR CREAM
- 1 (4 OZ) JAR DRIED BEEF, CHOPPED
- 1/3 CUP CHOPPED GREEN CHILE PEPPERS
- 1/2 CUP CHOPPED GREEN ONIONS
- 1/2 TSP. WORCESTERSHIRE SAUCE



DIRECTIONS

PREHEAT OVEN TO 350 DEGREES F.

CUT TOP OFF ROUND BREAD LOAF. SCOOP OUT BREAD FROM THE INTERIOR OF THE LOAF, LEAVING A HOLLOWED SHELL. RESERVE TOP AND REMOVED BREAD.

IN A MEDIUM BOWL, MIX TOGETHER CHEDDAR CHEESE, CREAM CHEESE, SOUR CREAM, DRIED BEEF, GREEN CHILE PEPPERS, GREEN ONIONS AND WORCESTERSHIRE SAUCE. TRANSFER THE MIXTURE TO THE HOLLOWED BREAD. REPLACE TOP OF BREAD.

WRAP BREAD WITH FOIL AND BAKE IN THE PREHEATED OVEN 90 MINUTES. SERVE WITH PIECES OF THE SCOOPED OUT BREAD AND CRACKERS.

GARDEN AREAS

The Tiger Lake HOA contracts with lawn services that cut and edge your yard, fertilize, and spray for weeds and insects. They do minor tree trimming and care for common areas. They do not tend to garden areas around your home or around the trees in your front yard. This is the responsibility of the homeowner/management company/renter.

If you are a renter, there should be an understanding between you and the property owner/management company about who is responsible for maintenance.

Failure to maintain garden areas may result in the HOA having them trimmed and cleaned. A bill for such services will be sent to the homeowner/management company.
