'TIS THE SEASON... FEMA SUGGESTED BASIC HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT

1. WATER - ONE GALLON OF WATER PER PERSON PER DAY FOR AT LEAST THREE DAYS, FOR DRINKING AND SANITATION.
2. FOOD- AT LEAST A THREE-DAY SUPPLY OF NON-PERISHABLE FOOD.
3. BATTERY-POWERED RADIO AND EXTRA BATTERIES.
4. FLASHLIGHT AND EXTRA BATTERIES.
5. FIRST-AID KIT.
6. MOIST TOWELETTES, GARBAGE BAGS AND PLASTIC TIES FOR PERSONAL SANITATION.
7. WRENCH OR PLIERS TO TURN OFF UTILITIES.
8. LOCAL MAPS.
9. CLOTH FACE COVERINGS (FOR AGES 2 AND ABOVE), SOAP, HAND SANITIZER, DISINFECTING WIPES TO DISINFECT SURFACES.
10. PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS AND NON-PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS SUCH AS PAIN RELIEVERS, ANTI-DIARRHEA MEDICATION, ANTACIDS OR LAXATIVES.
11. PRESCRIPTION EYEGLASSES AND CONTACT LENS SOLUTION.
12. INFANT FORMULA, BOTTLES, DIAPERS, WIPES AND DIAPER RASH CREAM.
13. PET FOOD AND EXTRA WATER FOR YOUR PET.
14. CASH OR TRAVELER'S CHECKS.
15. IMPORTANT FAMILY DOCUMENTS SUCH AS COPIES OF INSURANCE POLICIES, IDENTIFICATION AND BANK ACCOUNT RECORDS SAVED ELECTRONICALLY OR IN A WATERPROOF, PORTABLE CONTAINER.
16. COMPLETE CHANGE OF CLOTHING AND STURDY SHOES.
17. FIRE EXTINGUISHER.
18. MATCHES OR LIGHTER IN A WATERPROOF CONTAINER.
19. FEMINE SUPPLIES AND PERSONAL HYGIENE ITEMS.
20. MESS KITS, PAPER CUPS, PLATES, PAPER TOWELS AND PLASTIC UTENSILS.
21. PAPER AND PENCIL, BOOKS, GAMES, PUZZLES OR OTHER ACTIVITIES FOR YOURSELF AND CHILDREN.



SHRIMP REMOULADE

COURT OF TWO SISTERS, NOLA

INGREDIENTS:

CREOLE MUSTARD 2 CUPS
CELERY, DICED 4 TBS.
GREEN ONIONS, CHOPPED 4 STALKS
PARSLEY, CHOPPED 2 TBS.
PAPRIKA 1 TBS.
SALAD OIL 1/3 CUP
WHITE WINE VINEGAR 1/4 CUP
GARLIC, PUREED 4 TBS.
SALT 1 DASH
PREPARED HORSERADISH 3 TBS.
WORCESTERSHIRE SAUCE 1 TBS.

METHOD:

- IN A MIXER OR BLENDER, COMBINE ALL INGREDIENTS AND BLEND UNTIL SMOOTH.
- CHILL COMPLETELY.
- SERVE OVER MEDIUM BOILED SHRIMP ARRANGED ON A BED OF SHREDDED LETTUCE.
- YIELDS 3 CUPS.



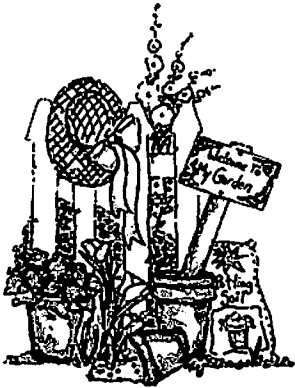
