HAMBURGER POTATO CASSEROLE INGREDIENTS:

1 POUND LEAN GROUND BEEF
3 CUPS PEELED AND THINLY SLICED
POTATOES

1 (10.75 OUNCE) CAN CONDENSED CREAM OF MUSHROOM SOUP
1/2 CUP CHOPPED ONION
3/4 CUP MILK
SALT & PEPPER TO TASTE
1 CUP SHREDDED CHEDDAR CHEESE
DIRECTIONS:

PREHEAT OVEN TO 350.

IN A MEDIUM SKILLET OVER MEDIUM HEAT, BROWN THE GROUND BEEF; DRAIN FAT.

IN A MEDIUM MIXING BOWL, COMBINE CREAM OF MUSHROOM SOUP, ONION, MILK, SALT AND PEPPER TO TASTE.

ALTERNATELY LAYER THE POTATOES, SOUP MIXTURE AND MEAT IN A 9 x 12 BAKING DISH.

BAKE IN THE PREHEATED OVEN FOR 1 to 1 -1/2 HOURS OR UNTIL POTATOES ARE TENDER.

TOP WITH CHEDDAR CHEESE AND CONTINUE BAKING UNTIL CHEESE IS MELTED.
