PARMESAN POTATO STACK

INGREDIENTS

- 3 TEASPOONS BUTTER
- 2 TEASPOONS PARMESAN CHEESE
- 1 TEASPOON GARLIC POWDER
- 1 TEASPOON THYME LEAVES
- SALT & PEPPER
- 8-10 GOLD POTATOES PEEL AND CUT INTO VERY THIN SLICES

DIRECTIONS

- 1. PREHEAT OVEN TO 350°F. THEN, MELT BUTTER AND USE IT TO BUTTER YOUR MUFFIN TIN.
- 2. NEXT, CUT YOUR GOLD POTATOES INTO VERY THIN SLICES. WHEN FINISHED, PLACE THEM IN A LARGE MIXING BOWL. THEN, ADD MELTED BUTTER, PARMESAN CHEESE, AND SPICES. TOSS THE MIXTURE SO THAT THE POTATOES ARE COATED EVENLY.
- 3. Now, LAYER THE POTATOES INTO STACKS AND PLACE THEM INTO EACH INDIVIDUAL MUFFIN CUP IN THE MUFFIN TIN.

 SPRINKLE SALT AND PEPPER ON TOP.
- 4. PLACE THE MUFFIN TIN IN THE OVEN AND BAKE FOR 55-60 MINUTES, OR UNTIL THE EDGES ARE GOLDEN BROWN AND THE CENTER IS TENDER.
- 5. LET THEM COOL FOR ABOUT 5 MINUTES.
 GARNISH THE FINISHED POTATO STACK
 WITH PARMESAN CHEESE.

COLLECTED.



JUNE 21 IS THE SUMMER SOLSTICE, WHICH HERALDS THE START OF SUMMER IN THE NORTHERN HEMISPHERE. IT'S THE DAY WITH THE MOST HOURS OF DAYLIGHT, SO ENJOY! IN THE SOUTHERN HEMISPHERE, WINTER BEGINS AT THIS TIME.
