SUGGESTIONS...

You can help keep our maintenance costs low and keep our community clean by removing debris from your front and back yards and maybe even pulling up a weed or two. You can throw it away in your gray or brown trash can.

The landscapers do not pick up tree limbs and debris as part of their weekly yard maintenance contract. They are contracted to mow, edge, and blow.

We pay extra for trimming trees or shrubs and having them pick up limbs, etc., or fertilizing and/or weed control in the common areas.

Any chairs or yard items need to be removed from the lawn before the landscapers come on Wednesdays or they will skip your yard if it is not free from obstructions.

In addition, it would be very helpful and appreciated if you would maintain your backyards around the lake.

We need to keep debris from getting into the lake and clogging the drains or damaging the fountains.



Before the HURRICANE season starts in June, you may want to consider purchasing flood insurance. We are not in a flood zone, and it is not required.

All owners are required to provide EPM with your


"Declaration Page" of your Homeowner's Insurance Policy.



Million Dollar Dip

Ingredients:







- 2 cups Extra-sharp cheddar cheese, shredded
- 1 cup slivered almonds, toasted
- · 4 cup thinly sliced scallions

Directions

Cook bacon until browned and crisp. Remove from heat. Transfer bacon to a paper towel-lined plate.

Stir together mayonnaise and cream cheese in a medium bowl until fully combined.

Fold in bacon, Cheddar, almonds, and scallions. Serve immediately, or cover and refrigerate for up to 3 days.
