TRASH CAN STORAGE GUIDELINES

 All residents are required to store their trash cans inside their garage at all times, except during the designated trash collection period. Trash cans may be placed outside starting at 5:00 p.m. on the day before your scheduled pickup. After collection is complete, please ensure that your trash cans are returned to the garage on the same day they are emptied. Your cooperation with these guidelines helps maintain the cleanliness and appearance of our neighborhood.

ALL EXTERIOR CHANGES OR ADDITIONS TO YOUR UNIT MUST BE REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE ARC BEFORE YOU MAKE ANY CHANGES.
IF YOU ARE REPLACING YOUR ROOF, AN EXTERIOR DOOR, OR FENCE, CUTTING DOWN A TREE, OR ADDING A GAZEBO, ETC., ALL OF THESE IMPROVEMENTS MUST BE REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE ARC BEFORE YOU CAN PROCEED.
BEFORE INSTALLING A NEW ROOF, YOU MUST PRESENT YOUR ROOFING CONTRACT TO THE ARC FOR APPROVAL.
ALL THE ROOFS MUST BE IDENTICAL. THE SHINGLE TYPE IS EITHER TAMKO OR TIMBERLINE GAFC. THE COLOR IS "WEATHERED WOOD."



- Streetlights: Florida Power & Light will install new streetlights to improve safety and visibility. Residents may suggest additional lighting or deflectors to the HOA.
- Tree Care: Crepe Myrtle trees will be trimmed to maintain their health and beauty.
- Lake Updates: A new rip rap will be installed around the lake in August to protect the shoreline and preserve its appearance.
- Pressure Washing: Peterson's Pressure Washing will clean driveways, culverts, and sidewalks in February.
